

CSULA WINNERS OF 2008 MEDIA ARTS FESTIVAL

Two CSULA students received a Rosebud Award, one of the top honors at the 2008 CSU Media Arts Festival recently held at CSU Channel Islands, in Camarillo, CA.

The first place Rosebud Award in the television category was received by art majors Ian Lollar of San Dimas and Tyler Andersen of Diamond Bar, for their film "Ups and Downs". The two minute production won a \$500 cash prize for the students and \$250 for the Art Department at CSULA.
